Address Cory Lane, Boyton, Cornwall

(Note: On a visit to Boyton in 2002, no reference to or knowledge of Cory Lane could be found - Frank Argus, in 2010 Colin Morris Bowey suggests that Cory Lane is probally Curry Lane, 3km NW of Boyton.)

Departed London via Cork on 17 April 1844 on "Lord William Bentinck". Arrived Port Phillip Bay VIC AUS on 22 August 1844.

The "Lord William Bentinck" was a Barque of 443 tons which was constructed of wood in 1828 at Yarmouth England. Its hull was sheathed in metal and restored in 1833. Its home port was London. - Lloyds Register 1844

Worked as a labourer.

The Port Phillip (Mouritz) Directory of 1847 indicates that "Thomas Argus, labourer, and his wife Edith Veale Argus, dress maker, were living in Little Brunswick Street Collingwood.

Early 1850's moved to District bounded by Merri and Darebin Creeks.
